B.Ed Admission 2011-12 in

Private Colleges of Education of Kashmir Division

- On-line Applications forms are invited from the desirous candidates for B.Ed Admission session 2011-12 in Private Colleges of Education of Kashmir division. The candidates should have Bachelor's degree with 45% [General] and 40% [Category] marks in any disciplines from the University or any other recognized University as hold equivalent thereto by the University. The Graduate teachers under 10+2+2 scheme with minimum two years teaching experience in Government/ Government-recognized private schools, are also eligible to apply for the above Admission .
- The On-line Application forms should be submitted through Kashmir University Websites, www.kashmiruniversity.net & www.kashmiruniversity.ac.in.
- The auto-generated application forms should reach the office of the Dean College Development Council [DCDC] as per below-mentioned dates and along with Pay-in-slip in original for Rs.750 (form fee Rs.700+ IT fee Rs. 50) favouring Dean College Development Council's Finacle Account Numbers : 0007010100002714 in J&K Bank OR 31246177581 in State Bank of India respectively. This is besides attested copies of (i) Matriculation Certificate for Date of Birth, (ii)12th Class marks Card, (iii)1st, 2nd & 3rd Years Marks Cards, (iv)Post Graduation Marks Card, (v)State Subject Certificate, (vi)and Category Certificate, if any, issued by the competent authority vide latest SRO of J&K Government.
- The Prospectus shall be available On-line for further guidance regarding eligibility, Colleges, their location, history, etc.;
- The admissions shall be done purely on the basis of the eligibility, merit of the candidate at the Graduation level, his choice for a particular college/s etc. However, the candidates with Master's degrees shall carry additional points at the time of calculating their overall marks.
- The procedure for receipt and processing of Application forms, issuance of lists , closure of admission and duration of academic session shall be strictly as per the following:

- (i) Application forms incomplete , in any respect, shall not be processed for admission;
- (ii) University shall not be responsible for any postal delay and forms received after the last date/s shall , in no case, be entertained for admission;
- (iii) The admission so granted shall be subject to the physical verification of the candidates in the colleges through special/surprise/periodical inspections;
- (iv) The academic session shall be treated operative from 15th October , 2011 only;
- (v) No Private College of Education affiliated/to be affiliated with Kashmir University is/shall be competent to make admissions on its own or on behalf of the University of Kashmir;
- (vi) Candidates shall be admitted only in the Colleges affiliated with the University of Kashmir;
